MECHANICAL INTERFACES


The multiways female connector enables the connexion from a PCB to a molded frame.

The geometrical requirements for a proper interface are detailed on drawing 3905 R001 attached.


IMPORTANT:





CONNECTORS UNPACKAGING





- 1 Take one packaging plate out of carton.
 - Put the second plate on the top of the packaging one.
- 2 Return both plates.





- 3 Remove the packaging plate carefully.
- 4 Take connectors, one by one, as described on page 7/8.




CONNECTORS SPLITTING 1/2

The sketch here after shows how to handle the connector in order to split it without damage.


FIRST OPERATION :

Removing of the remaining attaches may be done easily as shown here after


